Each applicant shall submit the information required together with a non-refundable investigation fee as determined by city ordinance.

Ordinance 4.03.001

Solicitor: Any person who goes upon the premises of any private residence in the city, not having been invited by the occupant, or upon the public right-of-way or in a public area for the purpose of taking or attempting to take orders for the sale of goods, merchandise, wares or other personal property of any nature for future delivery or for services to be performed in the future. This definition includes any person who, without invitation, goes upon private property, or in the public right-of-way to:

- 1. Request contribution of funds or anything of value; or
- 2. Sell goods or services for educational, political, charitable, religious, or other noncommercial purposes.

Peddler: Any person who goes upon the premises of any private residence in the city, not having been invited by the occupant, or upon the public right-of-way or in a public area, carrying or transporting goods, wares, merchandise, or personal property of any nature and offering the same for sale. Peddler does include a person who distributes handbills or flyers for a commercial purpose, advertising an event, activity, good or service that is offered to a resident for purchase at a different location or time.
